I, \_\_\_\_\_, being a vendor located in Columbia, Tennessee do hereby make affidavit that I am exempt from the Temporary Vending Permit by the City of Columbia, Ordinance No. 3495 pertaining to the issuance of Temporary Vending Permit for the following reason:

Exceptions 5-910 Pursuant to T.C.A. section 62-30-104, this chapter does not apply to:

- A. Any corporation, community chest, fund, and other foundation organized and operated exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary, or educational purposes of which no part of the new earnings benefits any private shareholder or individual.
- B. State fairs, arts and crafts fairs, and other fairs and festivals conducted primarily for amusement and entertainment.
- C. Wholesale trade shows.
- D. The sale of agricultural or handcrafted products;
- E. A person, who operates a permanent business, occupies temporary premises and prominently displays the business name and address while business is conducted from the premises.
- F. Flea markets.
