The following items are required before the start of construction and the Notice to Proceed is issued:

- Inspection Fee that is to be determined after TDEC approval
- An adequate surety instrument that is to be determined after TDEC approval

The following items are required by submittal to the City of Columbia Wastewater Department for the issuance of any Certificate of Occupancy in any new development with a sewer extension in the City of Columbia:

- Testing of the sewer as specified in the City of Columbia Standard Sewer Specifications
- As-built drawings of the system as installed, as specified by the Standard Sewer Specifications or the Wastewater Civil Engineer, including the recording of any public easements to any property on which said sewer improvements are located. Said easement shall be no less than 20 feet in width
- CCTV video of the sanitary sewer system installed as according to the Standard Sewer Specifications
- An adequate surety instrument to warrant the improvements against defect for one year from date of acceptance by the City Council of the City of Columbia
- An offer of dedication of the sewer improvements, subject to city council acceptance
- An affidavit documenting no liens against the sewer improvements and an agreement to indemnify and hold harmless from any liens which may be asserted against same

The information supplied on this application is correct to the best of my knowledge. I understand this application is subject to review and all review results and notifications will be mailed to the POC address as indicated above. If this application is approved, I further understand capacity assignment cannot be granted until the execution of the Agreement for Sewer Line Extension, the submittal of plans and hydraulic calculations, the payment of inspection fees, the submittal of required forms of surety or payment bonds, and any other documentation or requirements needed must be received, reviewed, and approved by the Wastewater Director. Failure to submit or complete all requirements in the timeline set forth in the notifications may result in forfeiture of proposed capacity assignment. I also understand a written Notice to Proceed from the Wastewater Director must be received prior to the commencement of construction and construction must start within 12 months of TDEC plan approval, to be outlined in the Agreement for Sewer Line Extension.
